DISTANCE: 125 LAPS

QUALIFYING: Single Car Time Trials

Check in at the pit office upon your arrival to register car and transponder number. Pill pick for time trial order. Weight and ride height will be checked prior to time trials and the feature. Car must be on the grid in order by 5:00 pm (or other time posted by the Pit Steward) or lose one lap. There will be an invert to determine feature lineup. The invert number has already been determined by the Race Director; it is in a sealed envelope taped to the pit office wall. The Fastest Timer will reveal the number after Time Trials.

ONLY 24 CARS WILL START THE FEATURE. If more than 24 cars enter the race, we will run a Consi after all other divisions have qualified. Details will be determined by car count on Race Day.

FEATURE: Caution laps count 1 – 75 / Green Flag laps 76 – 125

You will not lose laps in the pits under caution during the entire race. Double file the entire race, unless officials deem single file due to length/safety. "Lucky Dog" in effect.

TIRES: Each car may buy 5 tires for the race: 4 stickers for Time Trials (and feature) plus 1 tire change during the race. 4 tires available for practice tires. Maximum tire purchase per car: 9

Note: Race tires are not in your normal tire bank. Practice tires will also be available for purchase. Tires will be marked at the scales. All cars will start the feature on Time Trial tires.

THE USE OF ANY KIND OF SOFTENING AGENT IS NOT PERMITTED! ANY CHEMICALS DETECTED WILL EARN THE CAR AND DRIVER AN IMMEDIATE DQ. Flat tires or severely damaged wheels must be declared flat or unsafe by the officials.

A ONE LAP PENALTY, PER TIRE, WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY UNAPPROVED TIRE CHANGE.

Jump Rule: One jump on a restart is forgiven. The caution flag will drop and the start will be no good. The jump car will keep their position for the restart. The leader must start the race. After a car jumps the restart once, if a second jump start occurs, it will also be recalled but the jump car will be sent to the rear as a penalty.

FOR VISITORS: 4 tires may be purchased the day of the race to be used for practice. These will become your spare or "scuff" tires for the race. An additional 5 tires can be purchased for the feature.

*The minimum age to enter the pit area is 16 years old under NJ state law. The track requires a copy of the birth certificate or Driver's License and a Minor Release filled out by parent or guardian. The New Jersey Safety rules can be found at wallspeedwayracing.com
